Here are the final details for the Reunion.

Most of us are staying at the Hotel Miramar (see photo this page and map back page) at 401 Havelock Road.

Official arrival date is 29 December 2005.

The first event is on 29 December - a gathering at Modesto's Restaurant at the Elizabeth Hotel at 5PM for drinks and finger food (S\$25 pay on arrival). Modesto's is currently called Pasta & Spice but will be renamed by then. Dinner can be booked separately when you are there or you can go elsewhere in small groups.

own steam to school arriving at 11AM to walk around and then lunch there at 1PM. Tickets for this cost S\$16 per adult, S\$12 per child available from me or Jane Warren at Modesto's.

bought a 100 year old farmhouse, which we are renovating and guess

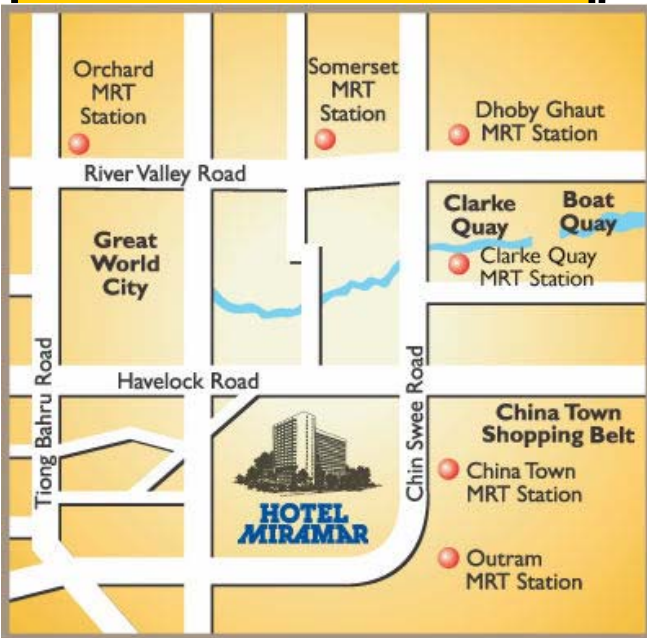


what!?! the guestroom was a priority and is ready for you!!
