For 5 nights, In on 29th December 2005 and Out on 3rd January 2006 including return coach transfers and daily breakfast:-

Land Only Bookings

FLIGHT arrival details for transfers (If no transfers required \$30 reduction in cost).

Deposits

Air and land bookings require a deposit of \$400PP and the balance usually 60 days prior to departure.

Land only bookings will have to be paid 7 days from confirmation.

Visa Card payments attract 1% surcharge; Amex and Diners Card payments attract 3% surcharge.

Passports

Must be valid for 6 months from departure from Singapore!
